QGIS Releases



- QGIS 2.x end of life since March 2019
- QGIS 3.4 is current LT version supported until end of January 2020
- QGIS 3.10 will be new LT version starting from end of October

Release schedule

The schedule is aligned to produce roughly the same dates for each year given our four monthly releases with LTRs in late february.

Beginning after 2.12 the development phase is always 12 weeks and the freeze phase is at least 5 weeks. Remainders are used to extend the freeze phase of LTR releases.

Point releases will happen every month on the latest release branch and the LTR branch, if there are backports.

In the first four month after it's release a new LTR is also the current LR. In this phase the new LTR doesn't replace the previous LTR in the LTR repositories. This happens as soon as a new LR is released.

The 2.18 release will replace the 2.14 release as LTR, but not replace 2.14 in the LTR package repositories before 3.0 is released.

QGIS Server




- OGC compliance reached for WMS part of QGIS server (version 3.4.6)
- WFS compliance not yet reached, but work started
- QGIS server now also a WMTS server
- Regular performance and validation tests established
- Many bug fixes and smaller improvements



QGIS Issue Tracker (bugs and features)

R#

- Migration from Redmine
 → Github Issues
- New URL: <u>https://github.com/qgis/qgis/issues</u>
- Requires creation of Github account for bug reporting or linking to other IDs (e.g. Google account, OpenID)
- Better integration for developers
- More modern GUI for bug reporters
- No categories → assign existing labels to avoid a mess in issue tracker



QGIS for MacOS: Standalone installer and all-in-one

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- Requires at least MacOS "El Capitan" (MacOS 10.11)
- Signed with OSGeo certificate
- Integration in QGIS.ORG server infrastructure
- Available immediately and now part of QGIS build and release infrastructure
- Many MacOS related bug fixes in the past couple months, including high-dpi issues

QGIS.ORG sponsors have been replaced by "sustaining members"




- Allows government agencies and universities who often can't "donate" to financially support QGIS.ORG on a regular base (once per year) by becoming a "sustaining member"

- Membership fees are not subject to VAT tax
- Change in effect since March 2019
